Student Safety Screening Procedure

In order to safeguard the well-being of all students at our facility, PRECISION Driving School, has implemented a precautionary screening questionnaire and temperature monitoring program to reduce the risk of exposure.

All Students will answer the following **3** questions:

- a. Are you experiencing Symptoms of COVID-19?
 - Fever, sore throat, weakness/tiredness, or dry cough.
 - b. Have you been in direct contact with anyone who is suspected of or is known to have COVID-19 within the last **14 days**?
 - c. Have you traveled to anywhere experiencing high rates of infection?
1. Students are required to have their temperature taken.(Infrared no touch thermometers will be used)
 2. Temperatures cannot exceed 100.4 F/38 C
 3. The instructor will take each students temperature before entering the vehicle.
 4. Both student and instructor will be asked to wear facial covering.
Vehicle will be sanitized whenever a new student enters the vehicle by the instructor.
 5. Each student will be given hand sanitizer prior to entering the vehicle

Action Steps:

Option 1. If answered **NO** to all 3 questions above; and your temperature is below the fever threshold, **you are clear to drive/observe!**

Option 2. If answered **YES** to ANY of the 3 questions above, or your temperature exceeds threshold;

We will need to reschedule your lesson.

What do you need to do next?

- Contact your doctor or clinic to get diagnosis.
- If diagnosis is COVID-19, your rescheduling date will be no earlier than 14 days from last symptoms.
